Be Mindful Of The Buying Season

Most stores buy clothes ahead of the current season. If it's spring, Twice As Nice is taking spring season items. That means that even though you might wear sweatpants in the spring time, don't be surprised if we are extra selective in what we take. Not only is it important to be mindful of the garment, it's also smart to pay attention to the colours in spring colours like white, yellow, pink, jewel tones, patterns and various pastels will likely be selected by any of us. Please be aware of the season and what you want to sell. All items that are stocked in our store are of Twice As Nice second boutique condition.

Keep Up With The Trends

While thrift stores will likely take anything you hand over, Twice As Nice is known to be much more selective. Trendy up-to-date and style definitely have a higher chance of being sold at Twice As Nice, as they're the items that shoppers will likely be searching for.

Look At The Condition

Twice As Nice requires items to be in perfect condition. So you should inspect your items thoroughly before you drop them off. Please make sure that there are no missing buttons, pockets are empty, no pilling, no unraveling hems and no stains. Purses must have no wear on the straps/handles, no ink stains/stains in general. Jewelry must be damage free and polished. Even though we ask you to bring your items in a box, please be mindful of wrinkles. Minor wrinkles we of course will take care of from the one fold rule we appreciate. Just because Twice As Nice is selecting used clothing, it doesn't mean it has to look, feel, or worse, smell used. Think about items you'd want to buy when you're putting together your boxes of clothing to be sold. Would you buy a worn out looking garment? We didn't think so♥

Pay Attention To Brand Names

If you're brand name obsessed, it's likely those items will sell at Twice As Nice. Popular designer brands are always being desired and if the item is still available in stores at full price, that's even better. A few designer names that we think are always sellable are: Banana Republic, Chaser, Calvin Klein, JBrand, Levi's, boutique brands, Michael Kors, and SO MUCH MORE! We do take Rickis, Cleo and other retailer brands. Twice as Nice wants clothing, shoes and accessories that are no more than three years old.

You'll likely get 40% of the price at which your items sell. Twice As Nice will not automatically mail you a check when your items sell. You'll need to call or visit the store to request payment. within four months of date of drop off.

A great tip is set a calendar date in your calendar or ask one of us to write it on a appointment card for you. When filling out the contract please be aware of pick up fees, wrinkle fees, and how you will receive payout amounts.

DOs and DON'Ts for Consigning

Do:

- All items are washed, wrinkle-free and folded in half only (NOT IN FOURS)
- All items must be dropped off in a box that can close or in a reusable bin with a lid
- All items are in a box or bin that you do not want/need back
- Items are in a box (NO BAGS) that is marked clearly with your first and last name and the drop off date
- Include a descriptive list of all items along with the sizes
- All items are in SEASON
- Check the quality of your items. Don't forget to check the pockets for cash!

After six years of being in business, we have carefully curated a list of what customers are looking for. We know what sells and what will get you money in your pocket.

Don't Bring:

- We will not attempt to sell items that have an obvious reason as to why you are selling them. Items that lack style, are frumpy, too traditional, are cheaply made or fast-fashion will not be sold. We are committed to quality!
- Brands we do not take: Ardene, Old Navy, Joe Fresh, Warehouse One, Shein, Kirkland
- We don't want matching three-piece suit, wide-leg dress pants or low-rise jeans. This is simply because it is not currently on trend.
- Jackets or coats with holes/stains/garbage/tissues in the pockets
- Bras with armpit stains, worn clips
- Swimwear that is see-through or saggy
- Clothing with tags cut. This includes brand tags as well as sizing tags.
- Pants with stretch wear
- Shoes with foot imprint. Use your hand and run it along the inside of the sole to ensure the quality of the sole. Also, check the bottom soles for wear and tear
- High heels with broken heels.
- Leather boots with stretched out calves
- Vintage items (grad dresses and wedding dresses included)
- Perfume that is less than half-full
- The onus is on the consigner to bring the paperwork to authenticate jewelry, purses etc. This takes the guesswork out of it on our end.

We are very thankful for the amount of support we have received. We are behind on inventory and want to continue to make this process efficient.

Please be aware that it may take time for your items to get out onto the floor. We are getting things out as fast we can.
